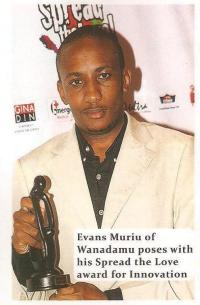
Love said the initiative would spread to Uganda, Zambia, Congo, USA, Germany, Mexico, and Haiti.
